Feeding instructions

- Frequent feeding (4 or 5 times a day) and even distribution are important practices to ensure the effectiveness of the flake diet
- Black Flake feed should be broken into small pieces for each feeding stage
- Feed (flake) will float initially, and then remain suspended in the middle of the water column for a long period of time while the shrimp feed
